The Department of Behavioral Health Services at Denver Health Medical Center is recruiting for a full-time psychiatrist to join our expanding Correctional/Forensic Psychiatry Service. The Behavioral Health department at Denver Health is an integral part of a Level I 525-licensed hospital, where medical and surgical services are readily available, with a mission of providing quality health care for all citizens of Denver regardless of ability to pay.

We seek a psychiatrist who enjoys working in a team-based and multi-disciplinary approach to deliver compassionate, evidence-based psychiatric care for persons experiencing mental health crises in the City and County Jails of Denver. Responsibilities include direct patient care, coordination NPs/PAs/psychologists/psychiatric nurses and social workers, and teaching of medical students, psychiatry residents, and forensic psychiatry fellows. The jails have a total population of 2300 inmates and all medical/psychiatric services are provided by Denver Health staff.
